**Walla Walla County Announces Three COVID-19 Related Deaths**  
***Reminder to Stay Home, Stay Healthy, Keep our Community Safe***

Walla Walla, WA – Walla Walla County health officials were notified that a local man and woman in their 80s and a woman in her 100s, that tested positive for COVID, passed away. We wish to express our heartfelt condolences to their families and friends during this difficult time.

Case Overview (as of 1/28/21 @ 4:32 PM):

- Confirmed Cases: 4,400
- Recovered: 4,118
- Deaths: 44
- Active: 271 (includes 31 WSP inmates & 2 WSP staff)
  - Home Isolation: 229
  - Hospitalized: 9
