Walla Walla County Announces Five COVID-19 Related Deaths Reminder to Stay Healthy, Get Vaccinated (when you are eligible), Keep our Community Safe

WALLA WALLA, WA – Walla Walla County Department of Community Health confirmed five deaths this week, four of which were reconciled from November and December 2020. County health officials were notified that a man in his 60s, a man and woman in their 70s, a woman in her 80s and a man in his 90s, that tested positive for COVID, passed away. We send our thoughts and condolences to their families and friends during this difficult time.
