Walla Walla County Announces Two COVID-19 Related Deaths Reminder to Stay Home, Stay Healthy, Keep our Community Safe

Walla Walla, WA – Walla Walla County health officials were notified that a local woman in her 70s and a man in his 80s, that tested positive for COVID, passed away. We send our thoughts and heartfelt condolences to their families and friends during this difficult time.

Case Overview (as of 02/25/21 @ 3:30 PM):

• Confirmed Cases: 4,720

• Recovered: 4,568

• Deaths: 52

Active: 100 (includes 1 WSP inmate & 5 WSP staff)

Home Isolation: 100Hospitalized: 0

Case counts are continuously changing as new cases go through the Department of Community Health (DCH) case investigation and tracing process. Washington State Department of Health (DOH) is currently reporting 60 COVID-related deaths in Walla Walla County. Currently DCH is in the reconciliation process on three and awaiting further details on the other five.
