Walla Walla County Reconciles Six COVID-19 Related Deaths Reminder to Stay Home, Stay Healthy, Keep our Community Safe

Walla Walla, WA – Walla Walla County Department of Community Health (DCH) was able to reconcile six deaths this week. County health officials were notified that two local men in their 60s, a woman in her 80s, and two men and a woman in their 90s, that tested positive for COVID, passed away. We send our thoughts and heartfelt condolences to their families and friends during this difficult time.

DCH was also notified of 59 cases linked to the Washington State Penitentiary from December 2020. These cases were not initially reported, and all 59 cases have recovered.
