Walla Walla County Vaccine Update
Reminder to Stay Home, Stay Healthy, Keep our Community Safe

WALLA WALLA, WA – Walla Walla Department of Community Health (DCH) was notified today, that they will receive 3,000 COVID-19 vaccine doses from the state on Monday, March 1.

DCH and health care partners will open their mass vaccination clinic on Saturday, March 6, from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. There will be approximately 2,000 first-dose appointments available for [eligible Phase 1A or 1B Tier 1](#) residents.

Eligible county residents will be able to start scheduling appointments on Sunday, February 28, at 8 a.m. Those who are interested in receiving a vaccine, should complete the following steps on Sunday:

- Step 1: Go to <https://www.covidwwc.com> and click the “Upcoming Vaccine Clinics,” button.
- Step 2: Scroll to the “Schedule an Appointment,” section and click “Schedule an Appointment,” after confirming eligibility.
- Step 3: Select an appointment time and complete the registration process.

It is important to note that no walk-in appointments will be accepted. If you are unable to schedule an appointment, please do not show up at the clinic to get your vaccination.

Residents without Internet or computer access can call the DCH helpline (509) 524-2647 and leave their name, date of birth, phone number, and a message stating that they do not have access to internet or a computer.
