Walla Walla County Vaccine Update
Reminder to Stay Home, Stay Healthy, Keep our Community Safe

WALLA WALLA, WA – Walla Walla County Department of Community Health (DCH) and health care partners will open the county's mass vaccination clinic on Wednesday April 14, 2021 from 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. specifically for Johnson & Johnson (Janssen) COVID-19 Vaccine. There will be approximately 300 dose appointments available at this clinic for eligible individuals. Effective April 15, all Washingtonians age 16 and up will be eligible to receive a COVID-19 vaccination.

Eligible county residents can begin scheduling appointments today (04/09/21) at 5:00 p.m. Those who are interested in receiving the Johnson & Johnson (Janssen) COVID-19 vaccine should go to the DCH COVID website, www.covidwwc.com or to the Washington State Department of Health Find a Vaccine clinic website, https://prepmod.doh.wa.gov/clinic/search, and search for **Walla Walla** to find and schedule an appointment.

To schedule an appointment, residents should complete the following steps after appointments go live:

- Step 1: Go to https://www.covidwwc.com and click the "Upcoming Vaccine Clinics," button.
- Step 2: Scroll to the "Schedule an Appointment," section. After attesting to eligibility, click the "Schedule an Appointment," button.
- Step 3: Select an appointment time and complete the registration process.

No walk-in appointments will be accepted. All eligible residents must have an appointment to receive a vaccine.

Residents without Internet or computer access can call the DCH helpline (509) 524-2647 and leave their name, date of birth, phone number, and a message stating that they do not have access to the internet or a computer.
