Walla Walla County Vaccine Update
Reminder to Stay Healthy, Get Vaccinated, Keep our Community Safe

WALLA WALLA, WA – Walla Walla County Department of Community Health (DCH) and health care partners will open the county’s mass vaccination clinic on Sunday, April 25 from 1-5 p.m. There will be approximately 1,000 vaccine appointments available to all residents ages 16 years old and over. Due to the slowing demand for the vaccine, this will be one of the final vaccination clinics held at the County Fairgrounds.

Residents can begin scheduling appointments today, April 16 at 5 p.m. All people interested in receiving a vaccine must be at least 16 years old, those who are not 16 are not eligible to receive the vaccine. People younger than 18 years old must bring a parent or guardian with them to their vaccine appointment.

Everyone interested in scheduling an appointment should complete the following steps:

- Step 1: Go to <https://www.covidwwc.com> and click the “Upcoming Vaccine Clinics,” button.
- Step 2: Scroll to the “Schedule an Appointment,” section and click “Schedule an Appointment,” after confirming eligibility.
- Step 3: Select an appointment time and complete the registration process.

Residents without Internet or computer access can call the DCH helpline (509) 524-2647 and leave their name, date of birth, phone number, and a message stating that they do not have access to the internet or a computer.
